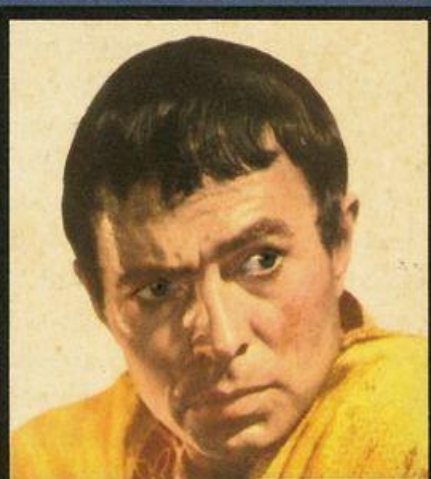

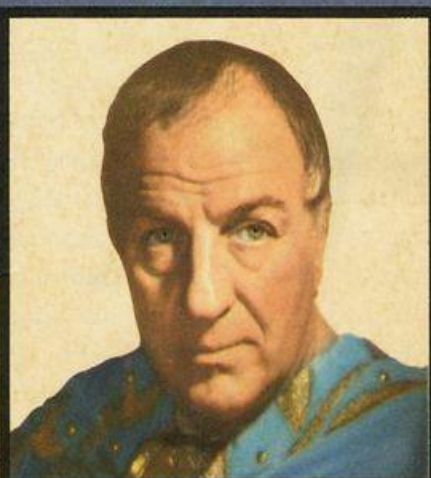

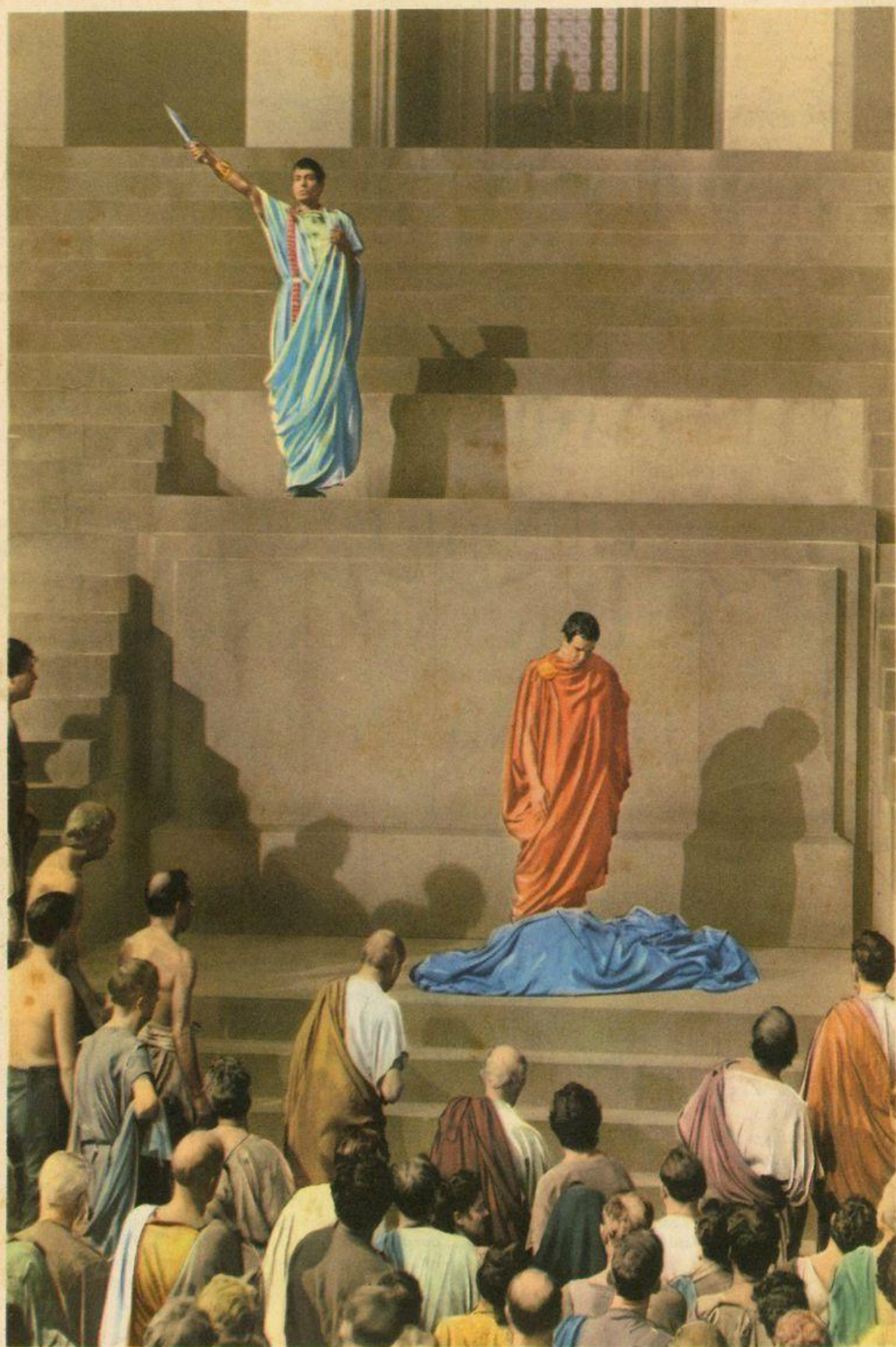

as *PORTIA, Wife of Brutus*

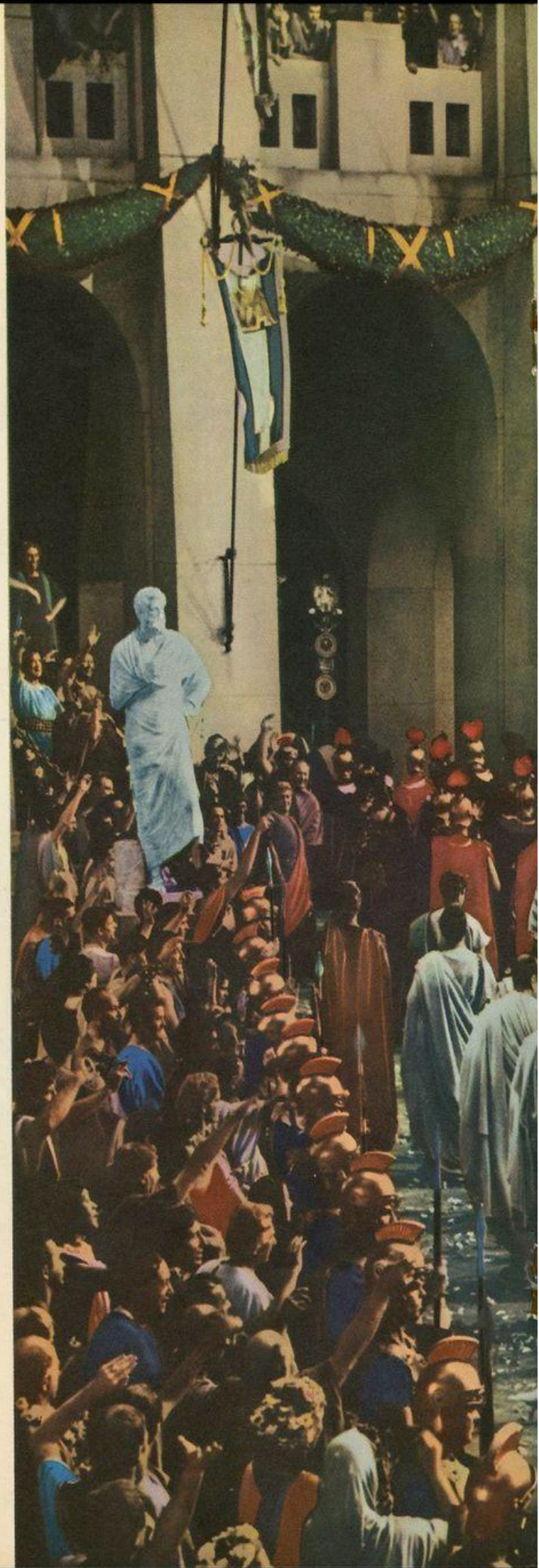
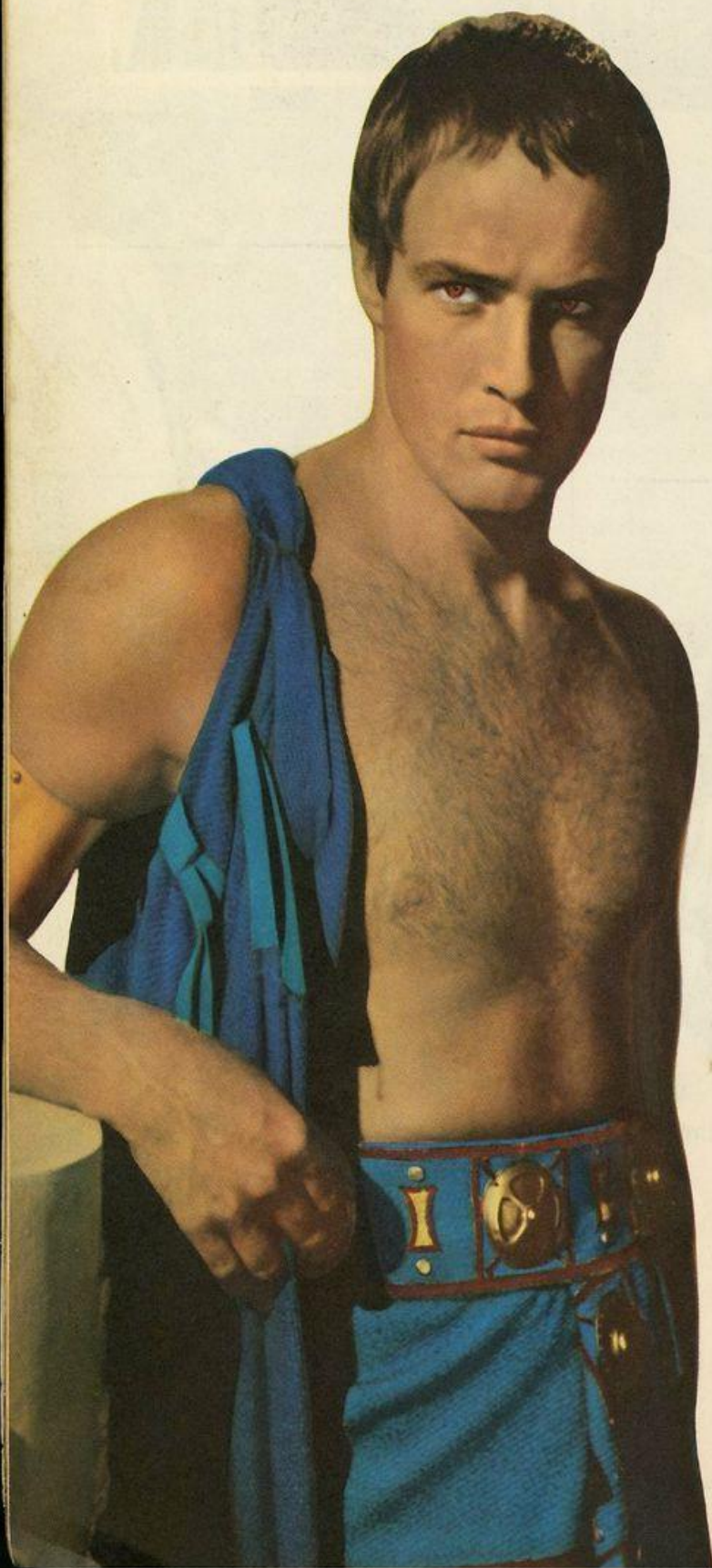

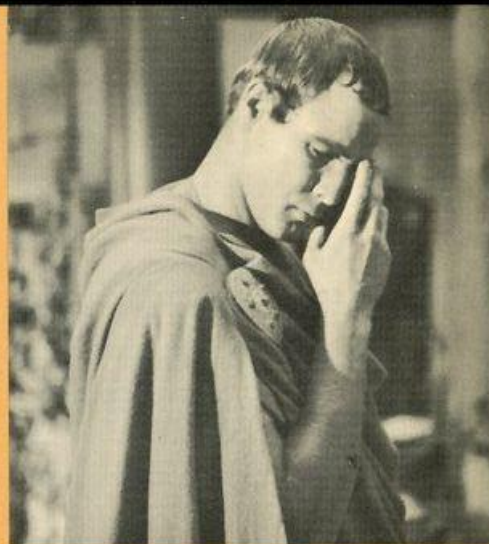




The evil that men do lives after them;

So let it be with Caesar.



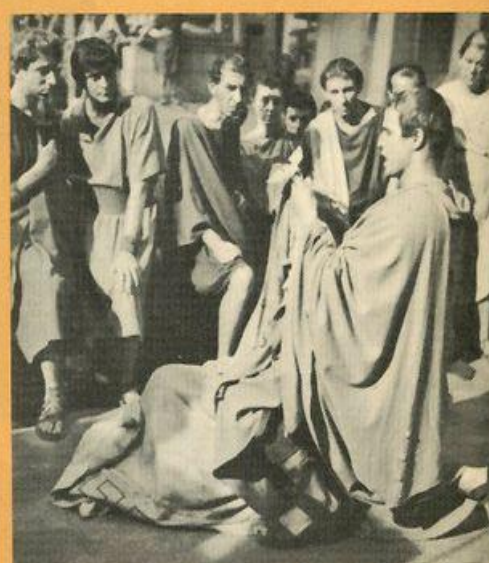

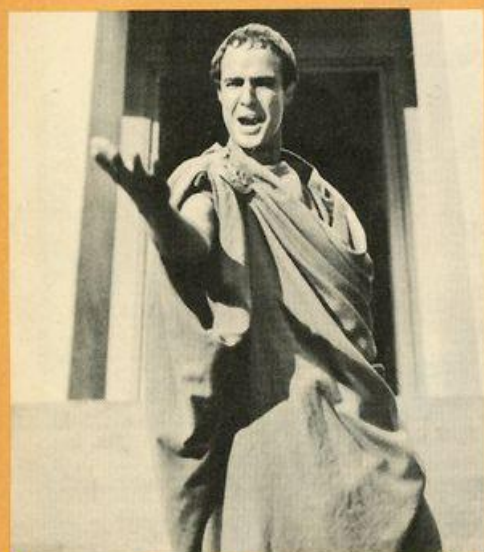
My heart is in the coffin there with Caesar,

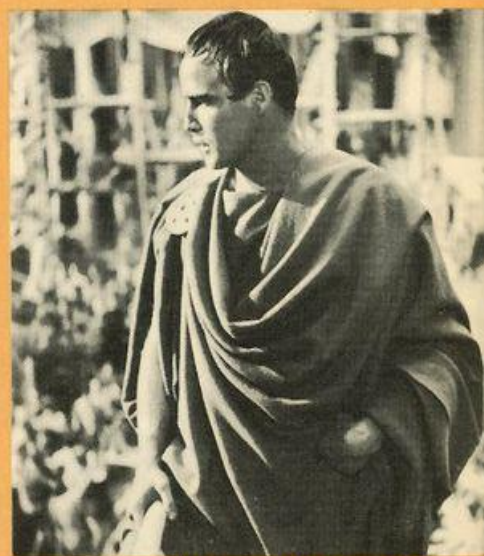
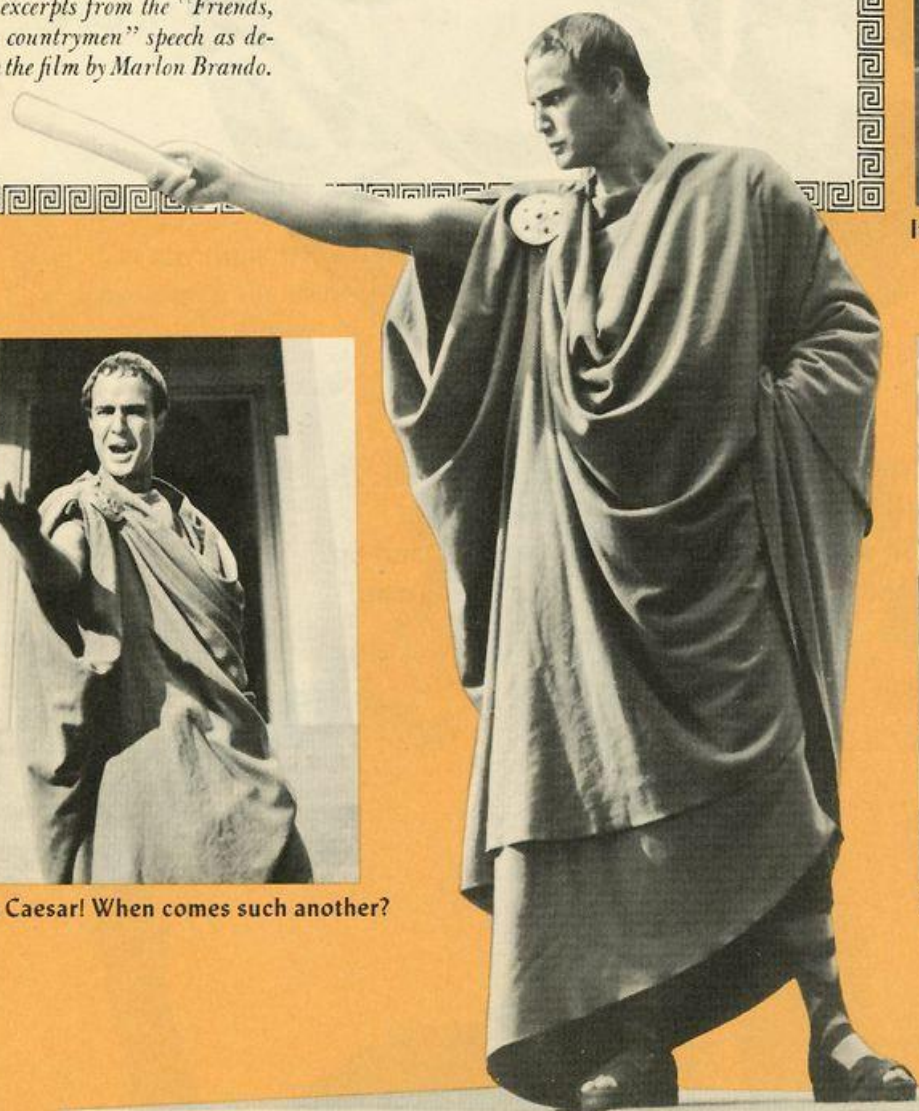
But here's a parchment with the seal of Caesar;
